**Q 01. Where Can I get Admission Application Form from?**

Ans. Application Form can be submitted online using URL  
<http://admissions.rmi.edu.pk/>

**Q 02. What are the steps involved in submission of admission form?**

Ans. The following are the prerequisites to apply for admission:  
Complete the online application form. Print the invoice for the application fee deposit.  
Visit any UBL branch and deposit the application fee as shown in the invoice. You can also deposit the admission fee through Easypaisa.

**Q 03. If I don't have email address, can I apply?**

Ans. Yes, you may apply. However, it is highly recommended to provide a valid email for correspondence.

**Q 04. Is there any provision for late applications?**

Ans. No, all applications along with complete information must be submitted by the deadline.

**Q 05. Is there any Financial Assistance or Scholarship offered?**

Ans. Yes, Scholarships are available for deserving candidates (subject to evaluation) after completion of admission process.

**Q 06. Is there any quota?**

Ans. No, all admissions are offered on merit only.

**Q 07. Is hostel facility available for outstation students?**

Ans. Yes, separate hostel facilities for male and female are available subject to availability of space.

**Q 08. Which test, ETEA or KMU-CAT, is mandatory and what are the passing marks?**

Ans. KMU-CAT is the mandatory test. There are no specific passing marks; however, a weightage of 40% will be given to the KMU-CAT score. Candidates with higher marks may have an advantage in being shortlisted for the interview.

**Q 09. What are the documents required at the time of submitting application?**

Ans. Application will be received online while all original documents shall be submitted at the time of interview.

**Q 10. How will I be informed about my application status?**

Ans. You will be informed through SMS,

Phone call or email.

**Q 11. How shall I get copy of Prospectus 2024-25?**

Ans. The prospectus shall be available online, or you can visit the website for it after submitting the online application form.

**Q 13. What is the fees structure for my college?**

Ans. Fee structure will be available in Prospectus as well as at the time of interview.

**Q 14. What is the Eligibility Criteria for admission on Local Seat?**

Ans. The following are the prerequisites for applying for admission:  
F.Sc Pre-Medical with a minimum of 60% marks or equivalent.  
A and O level candidates must provide IBCC equivalence certificates for both levels separately.  
KMU-CAT test scores for the current year.  
Valid CNIC or B Form (if underage).

**Q 15. What is the Eligibility Criteria for admission on Foreign Seat?**

Ans. The following are the prerequisites to apply for admission:  
Education equivalent to F.Sc Pre-Medical (60% marks) from a foreign country and university.  
IBCC equivalence certificate for both 10th and 12th grade separately.  
Valid SAT-II or MCAT or fresh Entrance Test (KMU-CAT) scores.  
Valid foreign passport.

**Q 17. Does RCRS conduct its own Entry test?**

Ans. No, RCRS shall conduct aptitude Interview for short listed candidates only

**Q 18. What are the documents required at the time of submitting the application?**

Ans. No documents are required when

submitting the application in hard form. Online application submission is mandatory.

**Q 19. What is my number in merit list?**

Ans. Please call the contact number of the college to which you have applied.

**Q 20. If I have to apply for multiple programs in RCRS, do I have to pay fee for each program?**

Ans. No. There is only one fee for all programs in RCRS.

**Q 21. Is entrance test of other provinces is accepted?**

Ans. Entrance Tests of similar nature with ETEA from all over Pakistan is accepted.

**Q 22. What is the duration of the Program offered by RCRS?**

Ans. Doctor of Physical Therapy a 5-year program comprising of 10 semesters and BS Speech & Language Pathology is a 4 years program comprising of 8 semesters.

**Q 23. Who is RCRS affiliated with?**

Ans. RCRS is affiliated with Khyber Medical University (KMU).

**Q 24. Is there any increase in the fee of RCRS?**

Ans. There is about 10% annual increase in the fee of RCRS.

**Q 25. How is RCRS academic calendar divided?**

Ans. The academic year of RCRS is divided into two semesters. The first semester runs from February to June and the Second semester from September to January.

**Q 26. Is there any application fee?**

Ans. Rs.1500/- is the application processing fee for RCRS.

**Q 27. Does the University have any sports facilities?**

Ans. RMI has its own Sports Complex and a Gym available for the students for sports and fitness activities.

**Q 28. Is migration possible to RCRS?**

Ans. RCRS entertains migration requests but with a strict policy.

**Q 29. Can I apply with a KMU-CAT test of 2018 or before?**

Ans. Only fresh is considered.

**Q 30. Is there any age limit and gender-based seats in admission to RCRS?**

Ans. The maximum age limit is 25 years. There are no gender-based seats. Admissions are offered strictly on merit.

**Q 31. Are there any other/hidden charges other than Application fee and college fee?**

Ans. There are no other charges. The students/parents shall inform the office of Principal/Vice Principal RCRS, in case of any such scenario.

**Q 32. What are the payment modes used in RCRS?**

Ans. All payments are deposited in the prescribed bank account with the details of students. No cash payment is accepted in any case.

**Q 33. Can I get a refund if I withdraw from the program?**

Ans. Refunds are subject to the university's refund policy, which includes deadlines and conditions. Please refer to the refund policy at the time of interview.

**Q 34. Is there an option to apply for admission on a part-time basis?**

Ans. The programs are offered only on a full-time basis. Part-time enrollment is not available.

**Q 35. What are the payment deadlines for fees?**

Ans. The payment deadlines are communicated at the time of admission. Typically, fees are due at the start of each semester. Please check the academic calendar or contact the finance office for specific deadlines.

**Q 36. Can I defer my admission to the next academic year?**

Ans. Deferred admissions are generally not allowed. If you are unable to join the program in the current year, you will need to apply again for the next academic year.

**Q 37. What facilities are available on campus?**

Ans. The campus includes a library, computer labs, a cafeteria, and recreational areas. Additionally, sports facilities and health services are available for students.
